

SCHOOL UNIFORM and P.E. KIT

The Governors have a policy on School Uniform which is to be followed by all students. The policy is based on the following points of principle:

- Students are to dress formally to reflect the professional learning environment at Bishop Stopford School
- Students are to have a common approach to School clothes and thereby reinforce a shared sense of 'belonging'.
- Students are expected to comply with simple common sense expectation which make up the School Uniform.

Item	Years 7 to 11	Notes
Trousers	Black and tailored	Not denim or tight fitting
Skirt (Girls)	Black and suitable for school (approx knee length)	Not denim
Blouse/shirt	Formal, loose fitting and plain white, tucked into skirt or trousers	Not denim or tight fitting
Tie**	House tie	Obligatory
Sweatshirt	Royal blue sweatshirt with woven School Crest	Obligatory
Shoes	Suitable black or brown small heeled or flat shoes	Not trainers
Coats	Coats for outdoor use only and appropriate for school	No Hoodies. No denim
Jewellery	Limited to one small gold /silver stud per ear lobe	No other facial piercings are permitted
Hairstyle/Make up	Discrete and appropriate for the formality of school. Hairstyle appropriate for School	No extremes of fashion

Sixth form uniform consists of blue or black trousers or skirt, blue, black or white shirt or blouse and blue or black sweater worn with a school tie. Shoes, coats jewellery and hairstyles must be suitable for the formality of the school. Extremes of fashion are not acceptable.

The Governors also expect a similar approach to compulsory **PE kit**:

Boys and Girls

White polo type shirt (short sleeved with collar) with School Crest*
 Royal blue reversible football/rugby shirt* (Boys only)
 Royal blue sweatshirt* with School Crest and PE Logo
 Royal blue shadow stripe shorts* for PE (Girls and Boys) and Royal Blue Rugby shorts* (Boys)
 Royal blue hockey / football socks* and plain white sports socks
 Plain navy blue tracksuit bottoms (no stripes etc)*
 Towel
 Trainers
 Football boots for use outdoors (Boys)

The PE Faculty advises the following for Rugby, Football and Hockey:

- ❖ Gum shields
- ❖ Safety (kitemarked) studs
- ❖ Shin Pads
