



In A-Level Drama and Theatre you should...

After each lesson...

Recap your lesson notes and contact your teacher if there are areas that you are unsure about. Check Edulink for homework tasks.

Every week...

It is expected that you will complete a minimum of 4hrs Private study. There is a booking sheet on the door of AC4 if you wish to book the space for additional rehearsals at lunchtime or after school.

Component 1 (Written Exam)- Revisit the sections of the texts (Our Country's Good / Accidental Death of an Anarchist) covered during the week and update notes and character trackers.

Component 2 (Devising)- Research subject matter and chosen practitioner. Make notes for Working Record.
