

Open Events

Open Mornings (Monday 9th, Tuesday 10th or Wednesday 11th October 2023, 9.45am – 11.45am) You are welcome to attend with your child. We will begin with presentations¹, and you will then be able to see a normal school day in progress, visiting Key Stage 3 lessons and touring our site with students.

Open Evening

The presentations given on Open Mornings will be repeated. You will also be able to spend time in each subject area and take part in activities, as well as talk to students and staff.

Pre-booking for these events is essential as places are limited. Please <u>click here</u> to complete the Open Morning Booking Form to reserve your place/s.

Parking

We can only accommodate disabled visitors' parking on our school site for Open Events. However, we provide a complementary bus service on Open Evening from the Cornmarket car park on London Road (Postcode NN15 7QA). It will run every 20 minutes from 5.10pm and throughout the evening. We strongly recommend all visitors use this service - or walk - to ensure the Headlands does not become unsafe. (For information, the Kettering Fire Station is situated next door to our school, therefore a clear access route is critical.)

If you still decide to park in the vicinity of school, please be aware of our neighbours and do not inconvenience them in any way.

Applications

If you do choose to apply to, please remember that you have **two** application forms to complete:

- 1. North Northants Council Application Form (which can be found on the North Northants Council Website)
- 2. Supplementary Information (A1) Application Form (returned to Bishop Stopford School)

Applications to join Year 7 in September 2024 must be received by the school by 5pm on **Tuesday 31st October 2023**. All applications received after this date will be treated as late applications. It is strongly advised that you talk to your faith leader before completing your Supplementary Information (A1) Application form.

We issue receipts for all A1 Forms received:

- If you hand deliver your A1 Form, a receipt will be issued by our Reception Team.
- If you post your A1 Form, we ask that you enclose a **stamped addressed envelope** if you wish to receive a 'hard copy' receipt so that it can be sent to you. Alternatively, a receipt will be sent by email to the email address provided.
- If you do not receive a receipt, email admissions@bishopstopford.com.
- It is the applicants' responsibility to ensure the receipt is issued to them and kept
