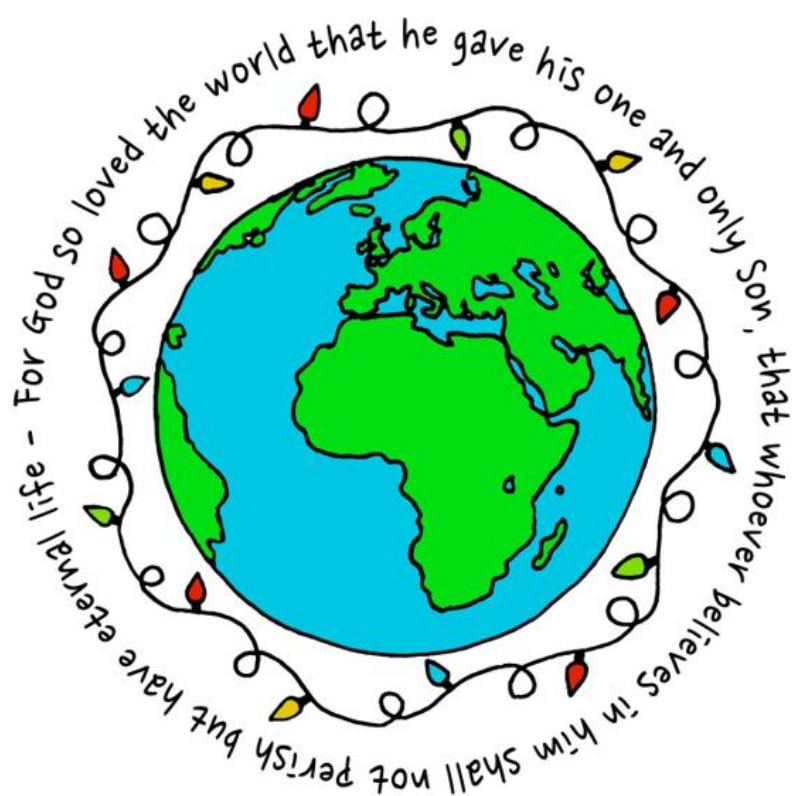

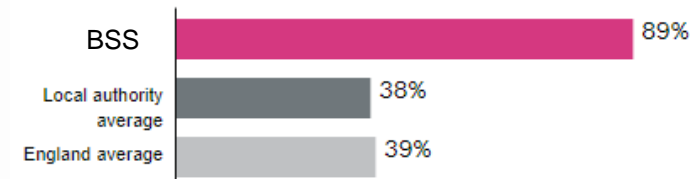

The challenge involved answering 25 multiple choice questions in 90 minutes and tested the students' logical application of Maths.

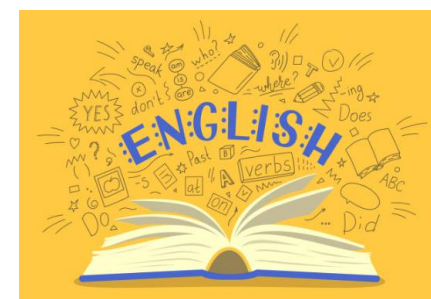

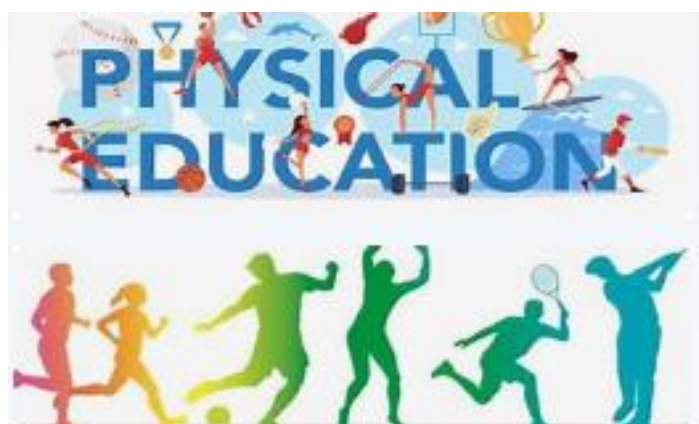
