## Year 7 Admissions September 2022

As you will understand, our plans for 'Open' events are provisional because of the pandemic. A decision will be made by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021 as to whether events can be held face to face. If this is not possible, we will provide a virtual alternative. Applications to join Year 7 in September 2022 must be received by the school by **Sunday 31st October 2021**. All applications received after this date will be treated as late applications. It is **strongly** advised that you talk to your faith leader before completing your Supplementary Information (A1) Application form. Offers are made via Northamptonshire County Council on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022. A right of appeal exists for those whose applications are unsuccessful.

The school issues receipts for all forms received. If you hand deliver your form, a receipt will be issued by our Reception Team. If you post your form, we ask that you enclose a *stamped addressed envelope* so that a receipt may be sent to you. Alternatively, a receipt will be sent by email to the email address provided on the application form.
