

What are the Entry Requirements?



Entry to our Sixth Form is based on achievement at GCSE (or equivalent qualifications). The General Entry Criteria is 50 or more “points” calculated on the grades you achieve in Year 11. The combinations for achieving the 50 points are shown below. You must also pass English with at least grade 5 and Maths with at least grade 4.

Subject specific entry requirements must also be met.

How to calculate your points

Bucket One Maths & English

+

Bucket Two EBACC

+

Bucket Three Open

MATHS

Enter your predicted Maths Grade	5
Double your point score: 5+5	10

Enter your **three highest predicted grades** from any combination of the following:
Science (up to three grades),
Computer Science, History,
Geography, Languages.

Enter the **next three highest predicted grades you haven't already used**.

You can put any of your remaining GCSE or BTEC* grades.

ENGLISH

Enter your highest predicted English Grade (English Lang or English Lit)	6
If you are taking two English GCSEs, double it: 6+6. (Otherwise leave this blank)	12
Add your Maths and English score: 10+12	
Total = 22	

Geography	5
Biology	6
Chemistry	6
Add these: 5+6+6	
Total = 17	

*If you are only taking two of these subjects then only fill two of the slots

PE	7
English Lit	5
Drama	6
Add these: 7+5+6	
Total = 18	

*BTEC points are calculated as follows:

L2D* = 8.5, L2D = 7, L2M = 5.5, L2P = 4,
L1D = 3, L1M = 2, L1P = 1.25

Add totals of Bucket One, Bucket Two and Bucket Three: 22 + 17 + 18 = 57 Points
