How we collect and use (process) your personal information

The School collects personal information about its staff, parents, students and other stakeholders and visitors who use our website.

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- You have made a complaint or enquiry to us.
- You have made an information request to us.
- You subscribe to our e-newsletter.
- You have applied for a job with us.

As is true of most other websites, the School's website uses Google Analytics to collect certain information automatically and store it in log files. The information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, operating system, timestamp and a history of the pages

you view. We use this information to help us identify visitor preferences and to design our site to better suit our visitors' needs.

Security of your information

To help protect the privacy of data and personally identifiable information you transmit through use of our website, physical, technical, and administrative safeguards are maintained by the School and our website provider.

Access to your personal data is restricted to those staff members who need to know in order to respond to you or action your information request.

In addition, we train our staff about the importance of confidentiality and maintaining the privacy and security of your information.

Third party links

Our website may include links to third-party websites, plug-ins and applications. Clicking on those links or enabling those connections may allow third parties to collect or share data about you. We do not control these third-party websites and are not responsible for their privacy notices. When you leave our Website, we encourage you to read the privacy notice of every website you visit.

Data storage and retention

The School will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements.

Sharing your personal data

The personal information the School collects from you is stored in one or more databases by our website provider and/or their third-part service providers. These third parties do not use or have access to your personal information for any purpose other than storage and retrieval.

The School will not share your personal data with any other third parties unless we are obliged to do so by law, or the disclosure is 'necessary' for purposes of national security, and/or criminal investigation, or we have your consent.

Data subject rights

The UK's General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act (2018) provide certain rights for data subjects. A good explanation of them is available on the website of the Information Commissioner's Office.
